



The BTRDA are pleased to confirm that Millers Oils will be continuing their support of the Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship again in 2010. Now in its 10<sup>th</sup> year, the BTRDA 1400 Championship has consistently provided the most competitive environment for competitors, with cars up to 1400cc running in advance of the main field on all events.

The 2010 Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship will consist of 8 classic Nat B forest rallies using some of the best stages in the UK (best 6 scores to count). All the championship events are aiming to achieve an entry fee of £400 or less in 2010.

The Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship will be divided into three classes to recognise the potential performance of the various cars.

- **Class 1.4L** - All current and former FIA Group N1 cars; cars that comply with a recognised 'UK One Make Challenge' technical specification; cars complying with BTRDA Rally First regulations but with non standard transmissions.
- **Class 1.4C** - Cars up to 1400cc with a maximum of 8 valve engines, plus cars up to 1,000cc not eligible for class F1000/RF1.0. Cars must not have remote reservoir suspension.
- **Class 1.4S** - All other cars up to 1400cc including current and former FIA Group A5 cars.

One of the exciting new prizes on offer to one of the Millers Oils 1400 Championship crews will be a trip for two people to the 2011 Malaysian GP as the guests of Silverstone Tyres and Service & Sport.

Millers Oils support for the championship is shared by all the drivers who will each receive a **£50 Millers Oils voucher** when they sign on for their first event. This can be immediately exchanged for 5 litres of Synthetic Competition Engine Oil or Synthetic Competition Transmission Oil, or 10 CVL bottles. There will be a **further £50 Millers Oils voucher** for each driver at the start of their fourth championship event plus some end of season Millers Awards for the successful crews.

In addition, all drivers in the Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship will be eligible to receive **£20 Finishers Awards**. These will be paid in cash at the start of the next Championship event the driver enters in the 2010 season, so a consistent driver can earn up to **£140** during the season.

On all events cars contesting the Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship are required to use tyres selected from the Silverstone Tyres range (gravel tyres only). Service & Sport, on behalf of Silverstone Tyres, will be providing a complete tyre support service on each event and competitors are encouraged to contact Service & Sport to discuss their requirements.
